On September 21st, 2011, Richard Cusimano and I delivered the trophy to Engine Company #54, Ladder #4, and Battalion #9, which is located 782 8th Ave., New York City. As you may already know, all members of this Battalion died on 9/11. The Company was surprised and grateful to receive the trophy from the Vintage Automobile Club of Ocean County NJ.

We were met at the firehouse door by Firefighter Andrew Sforza, who introduced Richard and me to Lt. McDonnell, Firefighters R. Berardi, and Firefighter F. Martinez. These are members of Engine Company #54. Ladder Co. #4 who were out on inspections. So, unfortunately we did not meet them; but I did get all their names as follows: Lt. Kazan, Firefighters Esposito, Mickey, Beyrer, and McLeod. Also out of quarters of Battalion #9 were Chief M. Meyers and Firefighter T. Clinton.

This was a very important day for me. As many of you already know, I am a retired Firefighter, and I just cannot understand why 343 of New York City's Bravest had to die on 9/11.

As painful as this was to their families and America in general, it was especially painful to Firefighters, retired or not. It never goes away. Once you are a Firefighter it's forever.

The Firefighters gave Richard and me NYC Fire Department Tee shirts. We were surprised and grateful to receive them.

May God Bless Our Fallen Brother Fire Fighters and their Families and keep the members of the New York City Fire Department safe.
